## Hoops Fundraiser Involves Chickens

Operation Chicken Hoops was announced this week by Carolyn Touhey, owner of Two Eagles Lodge and team coach Kevin Lee, owner of The Backstreet Pub.

In another unusual fundraiser to benefit the girls' basketball team at Vanier Secondary, the team is selling plump, fresh-frozen roasting chickens that were raised at Two Eagles earlier this year before being slaughtered at a B.C.-inspected processing facility in Errington.

The average free-range bird is five to six pounds with prices ranging from \$23 to

\$25. Two Eagles is donating a portion of each chicken's selling price to the team for tournament fees.

Two Eagles Lodge, located on 12 acres overlooking Georgia Strait and Denman Island, was built in 2007.

It offers guests private-entrance accommodations with private baths, a guest kitchenette, and a lounge.
